What you need:

Building Wood (different sizes

Nails

1 Hammer

1 Tape Measure

1Saw

Parent supervision

Getting Started:

This is a fun project for the whole family and should be done with the supervision of a parent. First choose a good tree to build in. Using the nails and hammer, start with steps on the trunk of the tree if needed. Use the tape measure and saw to cut the wood to the sizes you need. Then build a base for your tree house. A good idea for this is to use 2x4's to connect the branches next to one another. Once you have made some sort of a square connecting the branches, use this as a base for the floor. Nail down more wood across the base until there is a secure place to sit in the tree. Every tree house is unique so be creative. Make walls, windows, or more than one room if you can! Have an adult make sure it is safe and secure enough to play in before you use it.
